

Results Counselling for Uveal Melanoma Prognostic Genetic Testing

Your doctor may refer you to a genetic counsellor to discuss the results of your Impact Genetics Uveal Melanoma Prognostic Genetic Test. A genetic counsellor is a health care professional with a master's degree in human genetics or genetic counselling. The role of a genetic counsellor is to help you better understand your genetic results. The training they receive enables them to discuss technical genetic information in practical, useful terms.

What Happens During a Uveal Melanoma Prognostic Genetic Test Results Counselling Session?

The genetic counsellor will lead you through a discussion of your Impact Genetics Uveal Melanoma Prognostic Genetic Test results. As part of the results counselling session, the genetic counsellor will:

- Review the genetic tests that were performed on your uveal melanoma tumour sample
- Discuss the implications of the prognostic genetic test results, including your individual survivorship prediction results
- Explain benefits and limitations of the test results and their interpretation

If your physician refers you to discuss the results of your Uveal Melanoma Prognostic Genetic Test results with a genetic counsellor, you may schedule an appointment with a genetic counsellor from Labcorp, the parent company of Impact Genetics. Please wait four to six weeks after genetic testing was initiated on your uveal melanoma tumour sample before scheduling. Labcorp will confirm that your results are complete and ready to review prior to the results counselling session.
